ORDER

Administrative Approval is hereby accorded in favour of State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) and Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) for “Establishment of Polyclinics’ and ‘Upgradation of Diagnostic set up’ under XV FC Health Grants for FY 2021-22” at Urban Primary Health Centres (UPHCs).

Details are as follows:-

A. Polyclinics

1. Fixed day rotational Specialist services will be delivered through the Polyclinics for Medicine, Gynaecology & Obstetrics, Paediatrics for three days a week each speciality and Ophthalmology twice a week. Details in respect of recruitment of HR will be shared shortly.
2. The identified UPHCs for providing specialist services will be a hub for UPHCs/ Urban HWCs for providing Tele-consultation services.
3. The timings of U-PHCs with specialist services would be decided as per need of local community. Evening OPDs should be encouraged.
4. Name of the Specialist and timings should be prominently displayed near the entrance of the facility. Display should also provide information about the various services being offered.
5. Referral linkage should be established between newly set up U-HWC, Polyclinics and secondary /tertiary tier facilities.
6. Diagnostic equipment to be procured under 15 FC component through WBMSCL should preferably be installed in these UPWCs with Specialist services, for optimal utilization.
7. The ULB wise distribution of Polyclinic is attached at **Annexure-‘B’**

B. Diagnostic Equipment

1. Hematology Analyzer, ELISA machine and X-Ray machine with CR will be procured from State through WBMSCL and supplied centrally from the State.
2. Letter addressed to Principal Secretary Deptt. of UD&MA and Commissioner KMC regarding preparation of sites in accordance with civil and electrical requirements for installation of X Ray machine with CR attachment (already communicated on 1/12/2021) attached as **Annexure-'A'**. Assessment of fund requirement for the purpose excluding cost of Voltage stabilizer and UPS may be worked out through individual site visit, not exceeding Rs.3.00 lakhs per UPHC.
3. State Team may visit the sites periodically to review the preparedness of the sites for installation of the diagnostic equipment.

This order is issued with approval of the competent authority.
