3. The Essential Qualifications mentioned are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitles the candidate to claim selection. **All the essential qualifications must be completed within the last date of online application.**

4. Experience will be calculated after obtaining the required qualification for the above mentioned position, till the first date of online application.
5. Caste Certificate issued before the last date of online application, by the competent authorities of West Bengal only, will be accepted. In case of OBC candidates, category 'A' or "B" must be mentioned specifically in the caste certificate, otherwise the caste certificate will not be accepted.
6. In case of PWD candidates, Disability Certificate issued before the last date of online application, by the competent authorities of West Bengal only, will be accepted.

11. The online deposition of application fees can be done through net banking or credit/debit card system through an online interface. If the payment is successful, the candidate will be immediately reverted back to the link for final submission of the application form by using the application id already received at the time of Registration.
If the candidate wants to submit the requisite fee through offline mode he/she can do so with system generated e-challan. The fee can be deposited in any branch of United Bank of India (UBI) with the print out of the system generated e-challan after duly filling up the three parts of the challan. Out of the three parts of the challan, bank will keep one part and hand over the other two parts to the candidate. Candidates must preserve both copies with him/her for future reference.
The candidates can complete the procedure of final submission of application form within 2 subsequent working days from the date of deposition of the offline fees by using the application id already received at the time of Registration along with the transaction id obtained from the bank.
