Name of the Position : State Leprosy Consultant

Number of Vacancies : 1(Unreserved)

Consolidated Remuneration: ₹ 40,000

Age limit : Not more than 64 years as on the date of walk-in-interview for the mentioned position.

Essential Criteria : **MBBS with Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health / Skin VD.**

Trained in Leprosy and having experience of working as Medical Officer (Leprosy) for at least 5 years after obtaining PG Diploma.

The incumbent should be of sound health and should be capable of undertaking frequent visit to Blocks and Districts for supervision and monitoring.

Process of recruitment : Selection will be made on the basis of academic qualification, experience, training in Leprosy and Interview.


Reporting time: 11.00 am (no candidate will be allowed after 11.30 am)
