Age limit : Not more than 62 years as on the date of walk-in-interview for the mentioned position.

Essential Criteria : i) **MBBS with Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health / Skin VD.**
ii) Trained in Leprosy and having experience of working as Medical Officer (Leprosy) for at least 5 years after obtaining PG Diploma.
iii) The incumbent should be of sound health and should be capable of undertaking frequent visit to Blocks and Districts for supervision and monitoring.
