CIRCULAR

Whereas NIT No: HST/ 1P-106-2021/ DS/ 2021-23/144, Dated 17.09.2021 was invited for procurement of different types of Re-use Prevention Syringe of 2 ml, 3 ml, 5 ml and 10 ml.

Whereas Oyster Medisafe Pvt. Ltd. participated in the NIT and Award of Contract (AOC) has been issued in favour of the firm, vide this office Memo No. HST/1P-106-2021/748, Dated: 26.11.2021 for Re-use Prevention Syringe of 2 ml, 3 ml, 5 ml and 10 ml.

Whereas, Bank Guarantee and Agreement have not been submitted by the firm within the stipulated date.

Whereas, explanation was sought vide the office Memo No. HST/1P-106-2021/144/923, dated 16.12.2021 for non submission of Bank Guarantee and Agreement.

Whereas, the authority of the firm did not comply the Memo No. HST/1P-106-2021/144/923, dated: 16.12.2021.

Whereas, show cause letter was issued vide this office Memo No. HST/945, dated 21.12.2021 for personal appearance and to explain why penal measures would not be initiated due to violation of Tender Clauses.

Whereas, Mr. Subhasish Chakrabarty and Debasish Kundu appeared on behalf of the firm and submitted irrelevant explanation on 24.12.2021.


Whereas, another show cause letter was issued vide this office Memo No. HST/959, dated: 28.12.2021 to explain the cause of non execution of agreement.

Whereas, they replied on 30.12.2021 that they participated in the Tender without understanding the specification of the items. The Re-use Prevention Syringe is not manufactured by the firm.

Whereas, tender could not be finalized due to lackadaisical attitude of the firm and the TIA has fallen in to trouble to invite re-e-tender for those item.

Whereas, this has been viewed seriously by the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA).

Now, therefore the earnest money of amounting of Rs.100000.00 (Rupees one lakh) only is forfeited with 3 years debarment to participate in any tender of CMS, Govt. West Bengal as per provision laid in Clause Nos: 26(i) and 26(iv) respectively of the NIT.
