

In flight announcements to be made by all the airlines

- a. “In view of the current threat of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) reported in China and several other countries, all passengers with symptoms of fever, cough, respiratory distress and having travel history to China, Hong Kong, Singapore, Iran, Italy, South Korea, Malaysia, Japan, Thailand, Vietnam and Nepal in last 14 days or coming in contact with people having such travel history are hereby advised to report immediately to the airlines crew and also at the immigration/ medical unit on arrival. They should undergo mandatory health screening prior to immigration clearance. This is important for early diagnosis and prompt management for preventing spread of the disease. In case a passenger develops any of these symptoms within 28 days of arrival in India, the traveller should seek medical assistance from the designated hospitals and also inform the airport health office.”
- b. “You are requested to fill the Self Declaration Form being distributed before disembarkation and submit at the Health counters before immigration”.
- c. You are requested to ensure providing your correct and detailed address where you plan to stay in India and mobile number which you will use in India in the Self Declaration Form and also at Immigration counter.
