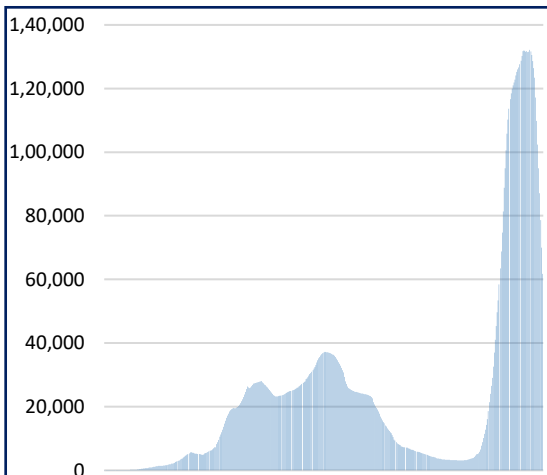

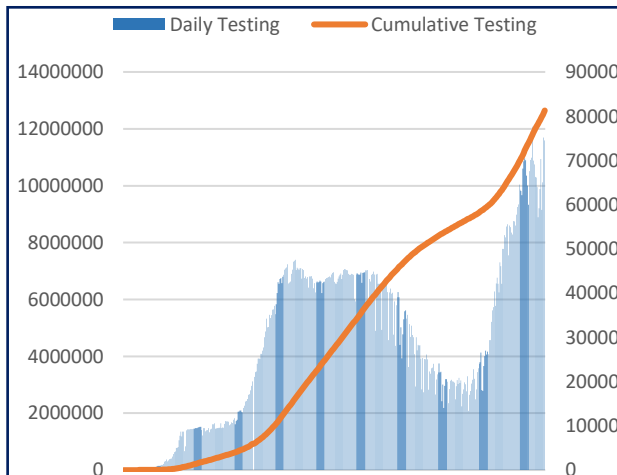
DAILY CUMULATIVE ACTIVE COVID-19 CASES

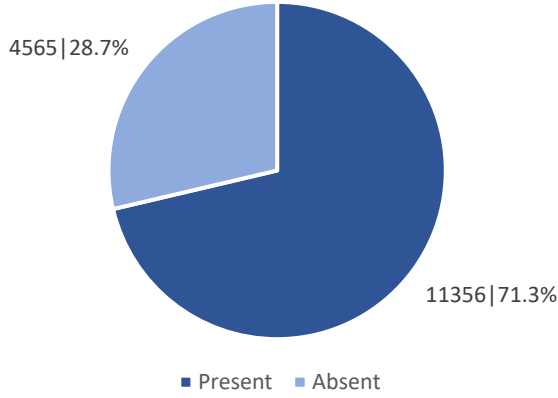

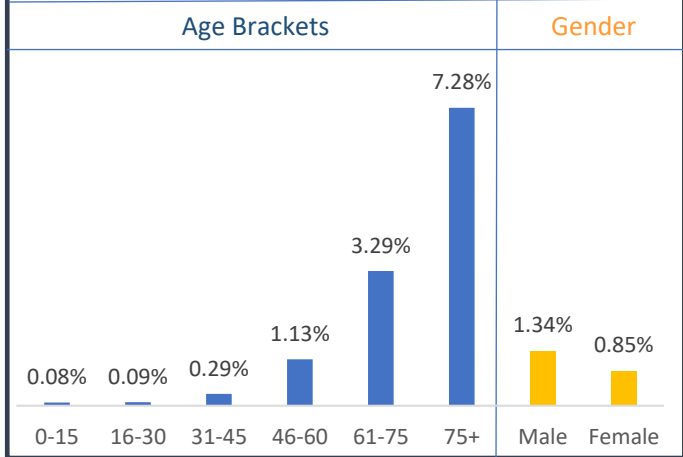

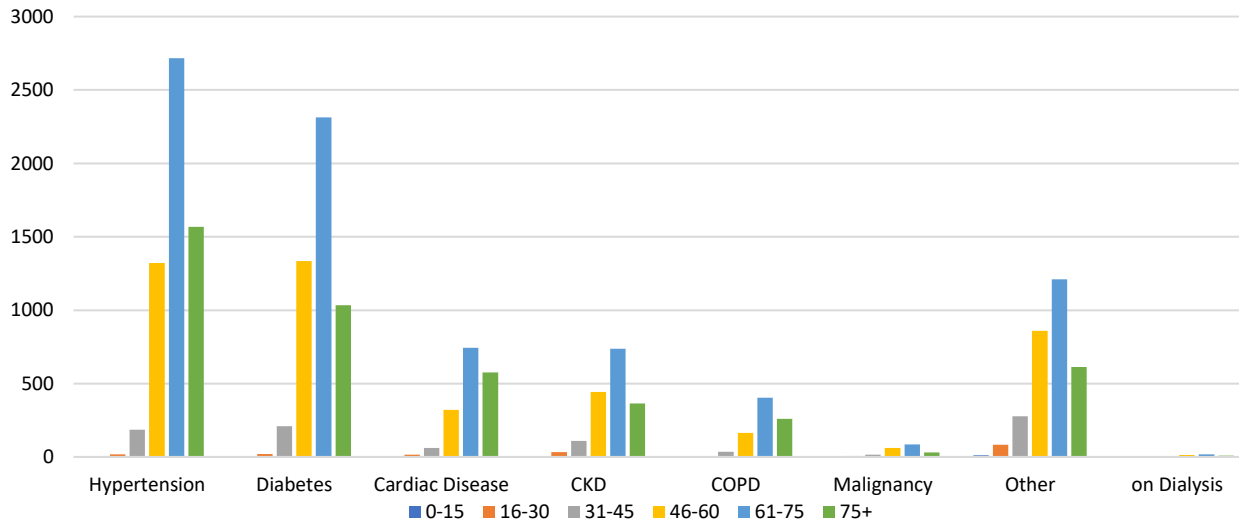
Comorbidity Status in Deceased Cases (n=15,921)



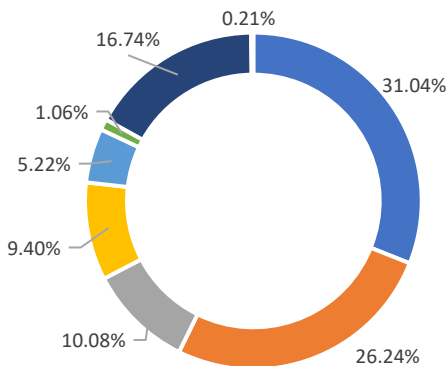
Fatality Rate in Respective Age Brackets & Gender Group



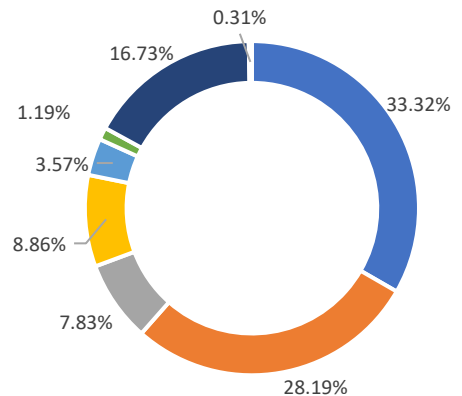
Age Group Wise Comorbidities Among Deceased

- Status of availability of beds for Covid positive patients in government and private hospitals along with other related services is available at https://excise.wb.gov.in/chms/CHMS/Page/CHMS_State_Dashboard_New.aspx
- Safe Homes : An initiative by the Government of West Bengal for care and treatment of asymptomatic/mild symptomatic COVID patients for whom home isolation is not possible /advisable
- As per State Government advisory Satellite Health Facilities are being developed by private hospitals in close vicinity of their hospitals as separate health facility for treatment of asymptomatic/mild symptomatic COVID patients. This intervention is expected to free beds in the hospitals for serious patients.
