Advisory for all Medical Colleges / All Medical Teaching Institutes

All the Medical Colleges and MTIs whether designated as Tertiary COVID-19 Care Centers or running Isolation wards for COVID-19 or suspect cases will utilize their existing strength of Interns for management of such patients judiciously.

For proper functioning and continuous patient care services, all the interns of all such Medical Colleges and MTIs should be placed for one month in the duty of serving COVID-19 cases/suspects and this will improve their knowledge and skill of management of COVID-19 cases. Placements will be done during their postings in the Departments of General Medicine/Chest Medicine/Community Medicine.

They will be awarded with "COVID-19 Warrior" Certificate from the Principal/Director of the respective institute.

Effective planning will be done by the College authority considering the academic requirement and the interest of public services.
