ORDER

This Department has planned to organize training of Medical Officers (MOs) on diagnosis of silicosis cases in 5 batches. Training will be imparted at R G Kar Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata. Accordingly Rs 3,82,500 was approved vide this Department's No 362/HFW/18059/1/2018-PHP dtd 16.1.0.2020 for organizing the training. Medical Superintendent cum Vice Principal, R G Kar MCH, vide his letter No RGKH/5736 dtd 8.12.2020, has requested to release the fund to RKS account of R G Kar MCH for conducting the training programme.

In view of above, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to accord Financial Sanction of **Rs 3,82,500 (Rupees three lakh eighty two thousand five hundred)** in favour of West Bengal State Health and Family Welfare Samiti towards organizing training of Medical Officers in 5 batches on diagnosis of silicosis cases.


