ORDER

The following 12 (twelve) doctors, as mentioned in the annexure, had executed Indemnity Bonds [as per G.O. No. HF/O/MERT/912/ME/MISC-78-13 dt.31.07.2013] during their admission to Post Graduate degree/diploma course of studies at different medical colleges as mentioned against their names in the annexure, under West Bengal University of Health Sciences in the year 2014.

In terms of the said Indemnity Bonds they were to serve the State Government for a period of 1 (one) year after successful completion of their courses failing which they were supposed to pay the Govt. a sum of Rs.10 (ten) lakh.

After completion of their courses they were deployed as contractual Medical Officers (Specialist) at the hospitals as noted against their names in the annexure vide G.O. No. H/MA/1523/HPT/32M-68-16 dt.10.08.2016 or H/MA/1702/HPT/32M-68-16 dt.22.08.2016.

The aforementioned 12 (twelve) doctors had served the State Govt. as contractual medical officers (Specialist) for a period of 1 (one) year as reflected in the annexure.

The undersigned is to convey that the Indemnity Bonds Obligation in respect of the noted 12 doctors now stands void and the original documents kept in the custody of Medical College/Institute are to be released.
