

Subject: Arrangement of management of Security Personnel sustain injury/ fall sick/ may be infected due to COVID-19 during WB General LA Election 2021.

In accordance to the letter from the Secretary to Govt. of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare, bearing no. 09(4)/Secy(JPM)/2021, dated 12.03.2021 and in connection with letter from the Chief Election Officer, West Bengal, bearing no. 1340-Home(Elec)/ R3E-67/2015, dated 26.02.2021, you are requested to arrange for earmarking of adequate number of beds at your unit/ units under your control regarding extending of the cashless treatment facilities / tie-ups/ prior arrangement , for treatment of Security personnel who may sustain injuries/ fall sick/ may be infected due to COVID-19 diseases , during election duty in West Bengal General Assembly Election 2021. This matter may please be treated as **MOST URGENT**.

A large number of Armed Police Forces from outside the State will be deployed in the ensuing General Election to the Lok Sabha, 2019. The State Government will make arrangements for transportation, logistics, accommodation and other arrangements necessary for deployment of such Forces in the State. The State Government will make available medical facilities to all personnel of such Forces in case they fall sick or meet any accident or get injured in some incident while being deployed in the State for the said Election Duty.

Now, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that all personnel of such Armed Police Forces from outside the State, while deployed for Election Duty in the State, will be allowed to avail medical treatment at private hospitals/ HCOs as per the norms of the West Bengal Health for All Employees and Pensioners Cashless Medical Treatment Scheme, 2014, as a very special case and at the rates admissible under the said scheme.

All Private Hospitals enlisted under West Bengal Health for All Employees and Pensioners Cashless Medical Treatment Scheme, 2014 are hereby requested to extend the Cashless Medical facilities as per norms of the said Scheme to the CAPF/Security Personnel engaged in the ensuing Parliament Election, 2019.

All Private Hospitals enlisted under West Bengal Health for All Employees and Pensioners Cashless Medical Treatment Scheme, 2014 will provide cashless medical treatment to the said CAPF/ Security Personnel on the basis of the recommendation of the Concerned Commissioner of Police / Superintendent of Police in the format enclosed herewith and the cost of resultant treatment is to be billed in accordance with the provisions of the said scheme for providing a package treatment or providing treatment / medical services for admissible items only. Any items of cost in relation to such treatment which are inadmissible as per provisions of the said scheme will be settled in between the HCOs and Patient concerned.
