**ORDER**

**Sub: Active TB case Finding (ACF) under NTEP in Financial year 2022-2023**

Active Case Finding activity gets a special emphasis for reaching the unreached vulnerable population in the community by ASHAs/HHWs/and/or Community Volunteers (CV) in every year.

In accordance with that the state has planned to implement fortnight long activity twice in FY 2022-2023 in all Districts as per the schedule mentioned below with the emphasis on meticulous mapping of vulnerable population.

The incentive for ASHAs/HHWs/and/or CV of ACF is Rs. 10.00 (Ten) only per house visit per team. An additional incentive of Rs.500.00 for each team for every new case of TB diagnosed and put on treatment during this activity is also admissible.

“Active Case Finding – Guidance Documents – June 2017” by CTD is to be followed in this activity. Expenditure in ACF activities is to be booked under respective heads of accounts under NTEP. (FMR code will be shared in due course of time)

For supervision and monitoring during activity one supervisor will get an incentive of Rs. 125.00 per day for at least five team supervision.


For different miscellaneous activities, such as contingent materials, meeting etc. during ACF period expenditure to the tune of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) only per lakh mapped population may be incurred.
