Corrigendum to the notification dated 14/07/2022 bearing memo no HFW-23099/298/2022/M/1642 regarding Circular for posting of Indemnity Bonded Open PG Students who passed final examination of WBUHS 2022


It has been informed by some colleges that some indemnity bonded open PG candidates who have already passed final examination of WBUHS 2022, are yet to complete their mandatory tenure of training required in Post Graduate course (2 year for diploma and 3 year for degree courses).

In view of the above, the circular dated 14/07/2022 as stated above is partially modified to the effect that such students must at first complete their mandatory tenure of training required in Post graduate course and only after that, they are allowed to join as Senior Resident.

During the completion of the mandatory requirement of Post graduate course, such students shall continue to obtain the stipend of post graduate period as per extant rule.

Rest of the circular dated 14/07/2022 shall remain as it is.

This is in the interest of public service and all concerned are hereby informed accordingly.
