MEMORANDUM

The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to permit one Medical Teacher of the West Bengal Medical Education Services as shown in the Annexure to undertake Post Doctoral course of studies and training in the discipline as noted against, at the All India Institute Of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, for the session January,2019 and for that purpose the Governor has also been pleased to place him on the Training Reserve for the period of three years with effect from the date of his release from his present place of posting or till the completion of the University examination of the course for the first time whichever is earlier.

2. During the period of his placement on Training Reserve, the concerned Medical Teacher shall be appointed in the Training Reserve posts created vide this department's memo number HF/O/MERT/50/W-70/2007 Dated 11-01-2008 with the approval of Finance Department vide their UO Number 4060 Group – 'P' (Service) dated 08-11-2007. The Medical Teacher will draw pay and Pay & Allowances as admissible to him while posted in such Training Reserve post in such manner as he drew at the time of his release from his present place of posting.

3. The Medical Teacher placed on Training Reserve is subject to the condition that he shall prior to his drawing Pay as Medical Teacher on Trainee Reserve Officer, execute bonds in triplicate in the prescribed form undertaking to serve this State Government for a period of at least five years after completion of the course. The duly filled up bond should be submitted to Special Secretary (MERT) for acceptance.

4. The Joint Director of Health Services (Accounts) will act as the DDO in this regard while the Deputy Director of Medical Education, West Bengal shall act as controlling officer in respect of such Medical Teachers.

5. The Pay & Accounts Officer – III, Kolkata, Pay & Accounts Office – III, Accountant General, West Bengal and other concerned are being informed.
