Sub: Administrative Approval for Procurement and supply of Chemical and Bio Larvicide for prevention of Dengue in rural areas in the year 2019

Madam,

It has been decided that larvicide required in rural areas for prevention of Dengue in the year 2019, would be supplied by this Department.

Director of Health Services has recommended use of Chemical Larvicide (Temephos) and Bio-larvicide (Bti WP Strain 164) on rotation basis to control Dengue in rural areas. It is estimated that total 6,840 litre of chemical larvicide and 1,16,970 Kg of Bio-larvicide (20 litre of chemical larvicide and 35 Kg of Bio-larvicide per Gram Panchayat) would be required for 3342 Gram Panchayats across the State for prevention of Dengue during June'19 to November'19 and it would cost approximately Rs 26 crore.

In view of above, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to accord **Administrative Approval of Rs 26,00,00,000** (Rupees twenty six crore) only in favour of Managing Director, West Bengal Medical Services Corporation Limited (WBMSCL) for Procurement of 6840 litre of Chemical Larvicide and 116970 Kg of Bio Larvicide to be used in rural areas. The fund will be released from the head of Account **24-HF- 2210-06-800-002-31-02** after receipt of requirement of fund from your end.

The Screening Committee has advised tender for procurement of Bio-larvicide regarding Dengue prevention vide P&AR Department's order No. 08/PAR/MCC(SC)/2019 dtd 29.3.2019. (copy enclosed).

You are requested to kindly arrange for procurement as per existing financial norms and deliver those up to Block Development Offices of 342 Blocks.

Specifications of the items has been prepared by DDHS (PH), H&FW Department and enclosed for your kind reference.

Assistant Secretary & DDO of this Department will act as DDO in respect of the fund and he is requested to make subsequent payment accordingly to Managing Director, West Bengal Medical Services Corporation Limited.



## BACILLUS THURINGIENSIS VAR ISRAELENسيس (BTI) STRAIN 164, SEROTYPE, H-14 W.P.

**Description of Stores Bacillus Thuringiensis Var Israelensis (Bti) Strain 164, Serotype, H-14 W.P.** As per specifications given in CIB registration Certificate and having the following composition and potency:-

### Composition:

Bacillus Thuringiensis Var Israelensis Spores-	5 – 8 % w/w
Delta Endotoxin	5 – 8 % w/w
Nutrient Medium Residues	30 – 35% w/w
Sodium Chloride	15 – 20% w/w
Powdery Lignosulphonate	22 – 41% w/w
Moisture	4 – 7% w/w

### Potency

- (i) 5380 IU/mg Min on Aedes aegypti
- (ii) 5370 IU/mg Min on Anopheles Culicifacies
- (iii) 5450 IU/mg Min on Anopheles Stephensi
- (iv) 5440 IU/mg Min on Culex Quinqefasciatus

**Shelf life/ Efficacy:** The expiry date i.e. the date up to which the larvicides shall retain its efficacy and potency shall be for a period of at least two years from the date of its manufacture which means that the material shall meet with the requirements given in the respective BIS specification / CIB

registration certificate for a period of two years. The firm shall have to be furnished along with the bid document. At the time when the stores are offered for inspection, the life of larvicides should not have passed more than 1/6<sup>th</sup> of the effective life of the same counted from the date of manufacture.

**Packing & Making:** The stores shall be packed as per the relevant BIS or where the specification has not been published by the Bureau of Indian Standards according to the Specification as indicated in the CIB Registration Certificate.
