- The undersigned is directed to say that as per guideline framed by the Indian Nursing Council in respect of 3 years GNM course, last six months are earmarked for internship of the students when they are paid monthly remuneration.

After careful consideration of the matter stated above the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to sanction a sum of Rs.1,64,96,000/- (Rupees One Crore Sixty Four Lakh Ninety Six Thousand) only for payment of stipend for 4 (four) months @ Rs.4000/- (Rupees Four Thousand) only per student per month for the period from September, 2017 to December, 2017 in respect of 1031 (One Thousand Thirty One) GNM internee students of 30 Nursing Training Schools as stated in the enclosure.
 3. The charge will be debited to the head of account "24-HF-2210-Medical and Public Health-05-Medical Education, Training and Research-105-Allopathy-NP-Non Plan-019-Training of Nurses-V-24-Scholarship and Stipends" during the current financial year 2017-2018.
 4. This order is issued with the concurrence of the Secretary of this Department.
 5. The Additional DHS (A&AV), West Bengal will allot the fund to the concerned D.D.O.
