


Sub: Regarding Post Mortem of Dead Body of a Disaster victim .

In reference to the above, all concerned are hereby directed that after any natural disaster or building collapse etc. the post mortem should be done on top priority and post mortem report should be forwarded to concerned Police Officer/B.D.O/S.D.O or Municipal Corporation within forty eight hours of recovery of dead body of a disaster victim: to process ex-gratia payments of disaster victims at a faster pace.




