In supersession of this office Memo No. I/32371/2018 dated 10.12.2018, and in terms of the recommendations of the Expert Committee dated 12/12/2018, the undersigned is directed to convey the approval of this Department towards direct procurement of the following 12 (twelve) Drugs listed in the Annexure, by the Indenting Units up to the Level of District Hospitals through SMIS, instead of the present practice of Central Procurement through CMS, subject to observance of the related formalities.

2. The undersigned is also directed to convey, as per decision of the Expert Committee, that procurement of the item Vildagliptin 50 mg Tab should remain restricted up to the level of District Hospitals, with immediate effect.
