Sub:-Administrative circular for Thalassaemia Screening by all Medical & Nursing students.

Sir/Madam,

Thalassaemia is a common chronic, life restricting genetic disorder which requires lifelong and specialized care & management. This disease causes severe distress and financial loss to the family and is a great drain on the health resources of the country. Government of India has launched the National Haemoglobinopathies Control Programme in 2016-17. However prior to 2016-17, this activity was running as a State Initiative in our state. It is a fact that detection of Thalassaemia carrier state in premarital stage by screening is the best possible way to prevent the birth of a Thalassaemic child.

With these facts, now it has been decided that all the authorities of Medical & Nursing teaching institutions under the Department of Health & Family Welfare are hereby advised to take all steps to motivate all students under their control to complete the screening of their blood samples to get themselves apprised of their status at the attached Thalassaemia Control Unit (TCU) with prior preparatory arrangements on the part of the TCU in batches.




