[Sub: Training of Medical Officers for CCU & HDU]

As per recommendation of State Level Advisory Committee and Technical Assistant and Support Team, a training programme for Medical Officers for different CCUs & HDUs will be organised in two batches from 12.10.2017 to 19.12.2017 at different training Institutes designated for CCU training.

Such training programme will be a full time residential training and to be organised in two batches,

1st batch of training programme will be continued from 12th October '17 to 12th December '17 (48 working excluding Sundays & Holidays)

- Training from 12th October to 18th October will be given at Critical Care Training Centre (CCTC) of Bijoygarh SGH (excluding Sunday)
- Training from 23rd October to 12th December will be given at R G Kar MCH, Medical College Kolkata and M R Bangur DH under active supervision of IPGMER

2nd batch of training programme will be continued from 23th October '17 to 19th December '17 (48 working excluding Sundays & Holidays)

- Training from 23th October to 28th October will be given at CCTC of Bijoygarh SGH
- Training from 30th October to 19th December will be given at North Bengal MCH - CCU, Howrah District Hospital under active supervision of IPGMER and SSKM Hospital - ITU.

Training centre wise distribution of the trainee Medical Officers is given at Annexure 1.

All MOs (as per annexure I) will report to the Superintendent, Bijoygarh SGH positively at 8.30 am on 12.10.2017 for 1st Batch and on 23.10.2017 for 2nd Batch.

Concerned Superintendents and BMOHs are requested to take necessary action to ensure the timely release of the respective MOs, so that they can join their training institutes as per schedule.

It will also be noted that the regular hospital services should not be hampered due to absence of these MOs during the training period. Necessary arrangement should be made by the respective District and Hospital authority regarding this matter.
