### ORDER

To combat probable 3<sup>rd</sup> surge of Covid-19 cases, it requires immediate provision of new Covid beds, augmentation of general and CCU/HDU beds at existing Covid hospitals, setting up of MGPS, laboratory, diagnostic facilities etc. It has been decided that 80 new PICU beds and 30 new general beds would be set up at Dr B C Roy Hospital, Belehata campus for Covid affected paediatric cases. For make this unit functional, procurement of drugs, consumables and furniture are required. Accordingly, Principal, Dr B C Roy PGIPS has placed requisition for the said procurement.

2. In view of above, the undersigned is directed to accord Administrative Approval and Financial Sanction of Rs 88,34,812 (Rupees eighty eight lakh thirty four thousand eight hundred twelve) only in favour of Principal, Dr. B.C. Roy PGIPS for procurement of drugs, consumables and furniture for starting 80 new PICU beds and 30 new general beds.

3. Out of the total sanctioned amount, the fund of Rs. 49,63,772 is placed against the activity head, Essential Drugs for COVID19 Management (ECRP-II) [RoP Code: S.1.3] [Tally Code: SA.1.3] under ECRP-II. Also, the remaining fund of Rs. 38,71,040 is placed against the activity head, ICU Beds added at Medical Colleges (ECRP-II) [RoP Code: S.2.4.1] [Tally Code: SA.2.4.1] under ECRP-II.

4. Financial Advisor, WBSH&FW Samiti will act as the Drawing & Disbursing Officer for releasing the fund.

5. Principal, Dr. B.C. Roy PGIPS is requested to make procurement after strict observance of existing financial norms.

6. The utilisation will be reflected by the institution in prescribed monthly FMR of ECRP-II, submitted to State FMG, NHM, WB.

7. Strict observance of all financial norms in respect of incurring expenditure out of the said fund must be followed and data entry in NHM-PMS portal must be ensured by the concerned health facility.

8. This is issued with the approval of Mission Director, NHM & Secretary of this Department.


