ORDER

Clinical management of Vector Borne Diseases especially Dengue cases is a high priority issue in the State. Considering the case loads of previous year and current year, **21 Blocks have been identified** and it has been decided vide order No. 140-HFW-27039/22/2018-CD Sec dtd 27.6.2018 of Director of Health services that fever patients will be admitted and treated. Administrative decision has been taken that arrangement of manual estimation of Haemocrit and platelet count is to be made at these **selected 21 high priority Blocks** and for this purpose, following items are to be made available at these 21 BPHCs:

1. Colorimeter
2. PCV tube
3. Pasteur pipette
4. Haemometre Box
5. Haemocytometre Box
6. Centrifuge Machine where these are not available
7. RBC, WBC and Platelet fluid.

In view of above, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to accord Administrative Approval and Financial Sanction to the tune of **Rs. 4,20,000 (Rupees four Lakh twenty Thousand)** only in favour of the Chief Medical Officers of Health of North 24 Parganas, South 24 Parganas, Nadia, Murshidabad, Malda, Alipurduar and Basirhat HD for purchase of reagents/equipment for manual testing of platelet in connection with management of dengue at 21 selected BPHCs.

District wise breakup of the fund is annexed separately.

All of the items are to be procured after observing all relevant Financial Rules & Regulations and as per delegated Financial Powers vide F.D. Memorandum No. 1659-F(Y) dt. 16th Feb'2018 and CMOHs will supply those to the concerned Block Medical Officers of Health.

Account Officer, Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health of the concerned districts and health districts will act as DDO in respect of the fund being placed.

The expenditure will be charged upon the Budget Provision under the Head of Account "24-2210-06-101-013-50-00-V" during the current financial year 2018-2019.


This order is issued in exercise of power delegated under Finance Department Memo No.1872- F.B. Dated 26.3.2018 read with the concurrence of Financial Advisor of this Department vide U.O. No. 769 dated 16.07.18.

Beside this, Pulse-oximeter for measurement of oxygen saturation in blood and Centrifuge machine for separation of serum from patient blood sample before sending the sample to SSL would be required at these BPHCs. These two items are Catalogue items. Therefore, concerned **CMOHs are directed to procure 2 Pulse-oximeters** (Rs. 10,998+ GST,


