NOTIFICATION

1. The Governor is pleased to appoint provisionally the following 1 (one) teaching personnel named below in the cadre of West Bengal General Service with effect from the date on which he joins as such and to post him as Statistician-cum-Assistant Professor until further orders in the medical teaching institution noted against him.
2. The appointment of the candidate has been made on the recommendation of the West Bengal Health Recruitment Board communicated vide memo number 205(CON)/WBHRB/2018 dated 05.04.2018 and will continue provisionally for 6 (six) months or until further orders with effect from his date of joining. This appointment is made pending verification of his antecedents and provided he is declared to be medically fit for Govt. service by Medical Boards on the basis of Medical Examination. If any declaration given or information furnished by the candidate is proved to be false subsequently, or in case of any adverse observation during verification of his antecedents or if he is found to have wilfully suppressed any material information he will be liable to removal from service without assigning any reason and/or any such further action as the Govt. may deem necessary under the provision or law.
3. The Scale of pay of the post is in Pay Band – 4, with pay band scale of Rs 9000 – 40,500/- with Grade Pay of Rs 6,600, and initial pay of the candidate will be fixed at the minimum of the scale or according to rules as the case may be. Besides the grade pay he is entitled to other allowances and benefits as admissible under orders of this State Government in force.
4. The appointee is debarred from undertaking private professional assignments of any kind, whatsoever including consultancy practice and coaching of students.
5. The appointee is required to contribute compulsorily towards employees Group Insurance Scheme and General Provident Fund at such minimum rates as may be prescribed by the Govt. accordingly to rules.
6. The appointee shall be governed by the terms and conditions of service as per rules and orders of the State Govt. as are applicable to the teaching Personnel of WBGS cadre under the Health & Family Welfare Department. Other rules and orders of the State Govt. employees of similar category shall also apply mutatis and mutandis in respect of the candidates. The appointment carries with it the liability of service in any part of West Bengal or outside. The appointee is required to perform all such duties as may be assigned to him from time to time besides the duties of the post in which he is or may be appointed. All other subsequent orders

issued by this State Government apropos service terms, conditions and pay etc, shall also apply towards him.

7. The appointee is hereby directed to report himself for duty to the Head of the Institution/ concerned immediately and in any case not later than **four weeks** from the date of issue of this order, failing which the offer of appointment to the W.B.G.S shall stand automatically cancelled without further reference to him and the vacancy will be filled by empanelled candidates as recommended by the Selection Board.

8. This appointment has been made as per the recommendations of the West Bengal Health Recruitment Board communicated vide memo number 20(CON)/WBHRB/2018 dated 05.04.2018.

9. The appointment of the candidate has been made in relaxation of rule 10 of West Bengal Service Rules, Part – I.

10. The 12 (twelve) posts of Statistician- cum –Assistant Professor @ 1 each for 12 (twelve) medical colleges under WBGS have been created in terms of this Department Notification No. HF/MA/O/MERT/957/4C-04/12 dated 14th August 2013.

2) Two copies of blank verification rolls are sent herewith to the candidate, who will submit the same (two copies) to the head of the institution concerned after duly filling them at the time of joining. The filled up verification rolls submitted by the candidate to the Head of the Institution should be forwarded to the Dep't immediately.

3) After his joining the Head of the institution concerned should take immediate steps for Medical examination of the candidate by a duly constituted Medical Board. The candidate is advised to appear before the Medical Board as soon as instruction in this respect is issued by the concerned Head of the institution, subject to Rule 10 of WBSR – 1. If the candidates fail (s) to comply with the instruction issued by concerned Head of the institution or if the candidate is subsequently found to be medically unfit his service will dispensed with. The report of Medical

Examination should be recorded in the Service Book of the Officer concerned. Cases found to be medically unfit should be immediately intimated to the Dep't.

4) The candidate is required to submit a written undertaking at the time of joining that (i). He is not in any other service / job in any other place on the date of joining the WBS under Health & Family Welfare Department (ii) that there is no criminal case or civil suit pending against him in any court of law in India.

5) The Head of the Institution is requested to verify the Original certificates of the educational qualifications and documents before the candidates are allowed to join.

6) Papers to be checked and verified by the Head of the Institutions before allowing the candidate to join –

1. (From School leaving mark sheet / admit card / certificate): Date of Birth.
2. Qualification Certificate/ Mark sheets.
3. Original documents pertaining to Reservation Categories (wherever applicable).
4. Release order from the present employer (where applicable – especially in cases of in service Candidates).
