The charge is debitible under the Head of Account "2210-06-101-013-Other Diseases-50-Other Charges" in the State Budget during the current financial year 2018-2019.



All concerned are being informed accordingly.



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

- Name of the Scheme:** -Comprehensive Health Check up camp for senior Citizen and Old aged pensioner under the National Social Assistance Program (NSAP).
- b. **Aim:** - Regular and periodical Health Check up (in July and December) will ensure that Old people will have "Better life with sound Health".
 - c. **Place selected for Camp:** In each Block the Camp will be organized twice in a year (in July and December) at the GP Hq. Sub-centre within the jurisdiction of the Block.
 - d. **Regular follow up & continued better treatment given:** After completion of 1st health check up, all the registered (at GP Sub-centre) elderly people will be regularly followed up in the OPD of the PHC, BPHC, RH and SDH with their Treatment & Referral card when desired and needed. If required, Indoor treatment at IPD also to be given.
 - e. **Eligibility:**
 1. All persons above the age of 60 years.
 2. Under the National Social Assistance program, poor & BPL persons who are enlisted at the GP level for financial Assistance as old aged pensioners.
 - f. **Details of the program:** Health Check up will be organized at the nearest GP Sub-centre twice in a year i.e. in July and December. District & the Panchayet Administration may be requested to arrange for local transportation and other logistic support for bringing the beneficiaries to the designated camp.

Deputy CMOH-II of the District will be the Nodal Officers of the Program. Under guidance of the CMOH & Dy. CMOH-II, the BMOH will organize the camp. BMOH will plan in advance for selection of the venue, date, arrangement of man power, requirement of medicine, IEC, screening criteria etc.

Camps should be synchronized with the GP based Health Camp that is organized for RCH under NRHM. Each camp will be conducted under the supervision of an MBBS Doctor; he may be assisted by "AYUSH" Doctors along with other Paramedical staff. Medicines required for implementation of the programs are to be procured through DRS. Rs. 500/- per camp has been allotted for medicines not available in the DRS which may be procured locally from the "Fair Price Shop".

The detail of date, time, venue, logistic and the expenditure involved may be worked out in consultation with the District Administration and other key Departments like the Panchayet & Rural Development, Social Welfare etc. After completion of each camp, report to be communicated to the State NCD Cell through the District Nodal Officer at the earliest.
