**MEMORANDUM**

With reference to Notification No. HFW-23099/29/2019/27 Dated 26-02-2020 and in pursuance to the proviso to sub-regulation (2) of regulation 7, Master of Dental Surgery Course Regulations 2017 issued by the Dental Council of India and in accordance to Memo No. HF/O/MERT/296/HFW-23-99/29/2019 Dated 04-03-2020 regarding TR, it is clarified that there shall be **no reservation of seats for in-service Govt. Dental Surgeons** for admission into Post Graduate Degree Courses from the academic year 2020-21.

As per Notification No. HF/O/MA/326/4P-01/17/Pt-II/HFW-25099/19/2019-MA Dated 28-02-2019 of the ACS and in pursuance to Cabinet Decision vide U.O No. 1093 Dated 27-08-2018 regarding amendment for fixation of permissible limit of Post Graduate T.R. every year in the West Bengal Dental Education Service and West Bengal Dental Service (Placement on T.R.) Rules, 2013 (Amended 2017), the strength of **total Trainee Reserve** will be **10% (ten percent)** of men in position who have completed a minimum 03 (three) years of service as on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the current year and thus are eligible as permanent in service.

**Fresh Trainee Reserve** for each year is determined by deducting the number of Dental Surgeons who are continuing their respective courses as Trainee Reserve, from the total number of Trainee Reserve permissible. The permissible T.R. strength calculated for the session 2020-'21 is 60 as the existing permanent strength of in-service Dental Surgeons of WBDS & WBDES cadre taken together would be 603 on 31-03-2020 whereas a total number of **16 (Sixteen) Dental Surgeons** are already continuing on T.R. Therefore, maximum **44 (60-16) NEET** qualified in-service Dental Surgeons would be allowed in the academic year 2020-'21, if selected.
