Order

State Government has planned to protect the children by augmenting in-patient Covid facilities both in form of general as well as critical care beds for the younger age group. Department of Health & FW has decided to establish 1300 Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) beds & 350 Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) beds at the existing Covid CCU/HDU facilities in different Hospitals for treatment of the Covid affected paediatric and neonatal cases vide order no 160-HFW-18033/14/2021-PHP, Dated 14.06.2021. To make these units functional effectively, Medical officers and Nursing staffs need to be trained for Paediatric Covid management.

For this purpose, in phase 1, a modular on-line training programme for Training of trainers has already been arranged vide order no HFW-14099/33/2021/262 dated 18.06.2021, starting from 23rd June '21.

Now, phase 2 of the training programme involving medical officers & nursing personnel will be started from 06.07.2021 as per schedule given below. Training will be given by the District level and Medical College level trainers who have already been trained in the TOT programme. Off line training will be arranged centrally by CMOH at the District level and MSVP at the Medical College level (for Kolkata area) in any selected suitable place. In 1st round of the training, MOs and Nursing personnel posted at different SNCUs will be given training batch wise. A training schedule matrix is given in the annexure (minor modification of the schedule in respect of trainee number may be done by District authority).

DMCHO of the respective Districts and DFWO for Kolkata will act as District level Nodal Officer of this whole training programme.

Dr Mihir Sarkar, Associate Professor , PICU in Charge , Medical College , Kolkata and Dr. Di-byendu Roy chowdhury , Assistant Professor , Department of Pediatrics Medical College, Kolkata will act as State level Co-ordinating Officer for this training programme.
