**MEMORANDUM**

The undersigned is directed to say that Dr. Banamali Sinha Mahapatra, of the West Bengal Govt. service, lastly attached as Professor, Community Medicine, Bankura Sammelani Medical College & Hospital, Bankura initially appointed as a Medical Officer on Ad-hoc basis in the unified cadre of the West Bengal Health Service, in terms of Notification No. Health/MA/3029/DHS/HPT/25P-5-81, dated 10.04.1981 and he had joined as such on 06.05.1981. Subsequently, his Ad-hoc services were regularized by the Government with effect from 27.07.1982.

Since his Ad-hoc services were continuous (without any break) from the date of his joining on 06.05.1981 till the date of his regular appointment in the West Bengal General Service as aforesaid, he was allowed normal annual increments in the time.

2. After careful consideration of the matter, the Governor has now been pleased to accord post-facto approval to the fixation of his pay and allowances on his regular appointment in the West Bengal Health Service with effect from 27.07.1982 at the same stage being drawn by his on 26.07.1982 which was derived at during the tenure of his Ad-hoc service as aforesaid and also drawal of subsequent pay and allowances by his in said regular service till his retirement, as a very special case, in relaxation of normal rules and orders of the State Government. The pensionary benefit of Dr. Banamali Sinha Mahapatra, would be determined on the basis of the last pay, thus fixed, drawn by him before his superannuation.

3. The Governor has also been pleased to order that the period of his Ad-hoc services from **06.05.1981** to **26.07.1982** followed by his regular appointment in the West Bengal General Service, with effect from 27.07.1982, would also be counted towards his pensionary benefits. However, she would not be allowed to get any benefit of weightage in the length of service in terms of Rule 27 of WBS(DCRB) Rules, 1971.

4. This order is issued with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O. No. Group-P2/2018-2019/0095 dated 10.05.2018.

5. The Principal Accountant General (A&E), W.B. and other concerned are being informed.


