ORDER

Due to management of COVID-19 pandemic many CHOs have been deployed in COVID Hospitals, Safe Homes, tele-consultation and other COVID related activities as per order issued from this end.

It has been observed that due to this deployment, population based screening of NCD, co-morbidity assessment with follow up of under treatment NCD patients and other services of Susasthya Kendras e.g. RMNCH+A, CD etc. are being hampered. Also, it has been noticed that on account of long absence of CHOs, the performance indicators of the Susasthya Kendras are getting affected.

Now that Nursing Branch has already posted more than 3600 new Staff Nurses in October, 2020, all concerned are hereby directed to release all Community Health Officers (CHOs) presently deployed in the COVID Hospitals, Safe Homes and other COVID related duties in the District HQ/Block HQ or any health facility immediately to enable them to join their respective Susasthya Kendras within 1st December, 2020.

This is issued in the interest of public service.

All concerned are informed for compliance.
