1. A District coordination-cum-sensitization workshop involving all key stakeholders. To involve Medical College/District Hospital housing the District Treatment Center, all other major hospitals, BPHCs, TIs etc.  
Time frame: Within 22.07.21- 27.07.21.  
Deliverable: A plan of action on increasing screenings, coordination and linkages.
2. All medical colleges within the ambit of NVHCP to organize a workshop involving residents from Medicine, G&O, Microbiology, Gastroenterology, Community Medicine etc on 28.07.21 with presentations on the following topics :-  
Why a Program to address Viral Hepatitis; Chronic HBV diagnosis & management; Chronic HCV diagnosis & management; Preventive aspects of Viral Hepatitis.  
Each presentation of 15 mins. Certificates/awards may be arranged.
3. A sensitization amongst identified at risk population groups on 28.07.21
