Order

It has been observed that various issues/demands have been raised throughout the State largely due to vacancies of Medical Officers in peripheral health units. **This has been reflected in the list of 'Paray Samadhan' issues already circulated at your end.** In some blocks or units, there is unequal distribution of MOs. To run the RH/BPHC/PHC optimally, the following arrangement should be made urgently:

1. A common pool should be formed with all Medical Officers posted within a particular block and they will be placed in roster duty from that pool covering all RH/BPHC/PHCs. The concerned BMOH of the block will deploy them on rotation basis to all non-bedded PHCs, bedded PHC and BPHC/RH within his jurisdiction so that it is possible to run all the health units with existing MOs of the block. This has a reference to the order No HAD/12 M-128-18/A 552 of DHS dt 05/10/2018.
2. There will be one MO in charge of bedded/ non-bedded PHC for administrative convenience.
3. The BMOH of the block will prepare the Duty Roster of the MOs immediately with proper intimation to all concerned. **The BMOH of the block should ensure that such Duty Roster is conspicuously affixed at the concerned health facilities by 05.01.2020 positively.**
4. ACMOHs of the subdivision shall be the nodal subdivisional officer for this work.
5. The CMOH of the district may depute MO in case of crisis from other health institutions for less than two months with intimation to the Director of Health Services and the same can be extended with prior approval of the Director of Health Services, West Bengal.
6. The CMOH of the district should personally ensure that this order is complied in his/ her district/ health district with confirmation to the Director of Health Services through email at ddadmnwb@gmail.com by 07.01.2021 positively.
7. **District Magistrates should ensure that compliance is appropriately reflected in 'Paray Samadhan' portal during entry at their end. This should be treated with highest priority in context of 'Paray Samadhan' programme.**
