M E M O R A N D U M

1. In terms of the Notification No. HF/O/MA/268/4P-01/17/Pt. I dated 19.03.18 and further Notification No. HAD/10M-07-18/Pt-II/M-152 dated 21.04.18, the total Trainee Reserve for the year 2018 stands at 196 in case of PG Degree and Diploma.
2. In keeping with the above, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to permit the **173 (one hundred seventy three) Medical Officers** of the West Bengal Health Services / West Bengal Public Health & Administrative Service, as shown in the Annexure, to undertake postgraduate degree/ diploma course of studies and trainee in different disciplines as noted against each under the West Bengal University of Health Sciences for the **session 2018** and for that purpose the Governor has also been pleased to place them on the Training Reserve for the period of three years or two years as applicable for each case with effect from the date(s) of their release from their present place(s) of posting till the completion of the University examination of the course(s) for the first time whichever is earlier.
3. During the period of their placement on Training Reserve, the Officer will draw Pay & Allowances as admissible to them under the West Bengal Health Services (Cadre, Pay & Allowances) Rules / West Bengal Public Health & Administrative Service (Cadre Pay & Allowances) Rules, as applicable for each case, and in terms of the existing Rules of this State Government.
4. The Medical Officers, as placed on Training Reserve are subject to the condition that they shall, prior to their drawing Pay as Medical Officer on T.R Officers, execute bonds in triplicate in the prescribed form undertaking to serve the State Government for a period of at least three years (for two years course) and at least five years (for three years courses) after completion of the course. The duly filled up bond should be submitted to the Medical Administration Branch of Swasthya Bhavan for acceptance.
5. The Joint Director of Health Services (Accounts) will act as the DDO in this regard and the WBUHS shall submit the requisite reports in respect of such Medical Officers, as desired by the Director of Health Services.
6. The Pay & Accounts Officer – III, Kolkata, Pay & Accounts Office – III, Accountant General, West Bengal and other concerned are being informed.


