**NOTICE FOR ADMISSION IN THE 1ST YEAR CLASS OF DIPLOMA IN
PHARMACY AT INSTITUTE OF PHARMACY, JALPAIGURI, KALYANI AND
BANKURA, FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023.**

1. The total No. of seats open for admission Institutions wise are as follows:

(a) Institute of Pharmacy, Jalpaiguri: U.R- 29, S.C- 11, S.T.- 03, O.B.C-A- 06, O.B.C-B-04, P.H.-03 (U.R.P.H=02 + S.C.P.H =01) and G.T.A Nominated- 04 (Total - 60)

(b) Institute of Pharmacy, Kalyani: U.R - 31, S.C - 12, S.T - 04, O.B.C-A- 06, O.B.C-B-04 and P.H - 03 (U.R.P.H=02 + S.C.P.H =01) =Total - 60

(c) Institute of Pharmacy, Bankura: U.R -31, S.C -12, S.T - 04, O.B.C-A- 06, O.B.C-B-04 and P.H - 03 (U.R.P.H=02 + S.C.P.H =01) =Total - 60

2. Four candidates nominated by the G.T.A., Darjeeling will be admitted in the Institute of Pharmacy, Jalpaiguri subject to the approval of Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal.

3. Rank wise the list of candidates, who have applied for the Admission in two years D. Pharm. Course for the academic year of 2022-2023 will be published in the official website of the Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal, Swasthya Bhawan (www.wbhealth.gov.in). The panel of merit list will be made through online based on merit and reservation quota, till all the seats are filled up.

4. a) The date of registration and payment for online application will be opened on 29.08.2022. The date of registration and payment for online application will be closed on 01.09.2022 by midnight.

Candidates must submit the required application fees through online for consideration of their application and fees must be submitted in the head of the account as given below:

Fees:-

(I) Rs. 500/- (Five hundred) only for unreserved candidates

and

(II) Rs 200/- (Two hundred) only for SC/ST/OBC/PH

The application fees to be deposited online (credit card/debit card/net banking) in favour of "The West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti" in the account of Punjab National Bank (PNB), Salt Lake-Sector-V Branch, A/C No. 1432010100410, IFSC: PUNB0143220, MICR: 700027238 in the Head of Account-Medical Education, W.B.

The online banking charges as applicable is to be borne by the candidate which is extra. The application is one time procedure & fees remitted is non-refundable.

b) The last date of online college choice filling and locking by candidates on 06.09.2022 by midnight.

c) The publication of the result of the candidates with allotted college based on the basis of merit will be notified in the official website of the Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal, Swasthya Bhawan (www.wbhealth.gov.in) on 10.09.2022.

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Candidates will be selected on the basis of total marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics or Biology (whichever is higher) at the H.S (10+2) Examination (General Stream) or equivalent examination as approved by the Pharmacy Council of India. **Candidates have to separately pass both the theory and practical examination in physics, chemistry, and biology (if biology is considered for merit list).** The tie shall be broken up by marks in Chemistry if still tie, then Physics and if still tie, then Mathematics or Biology (whichever is higher) & if still a tie then higher age would incur higher merit position.

Upgradation: This year upgradation will be available. During form fill up upgradation option will be there. A candidate may select or may not select upgradation at that stage. However, further during admission 1st and 2nd round there will be provision of upgradation for the allotted candidates at the allotted college during admission, except for the candidate allotted for the highest preferred choice. The upgradation sought or not opted by the allotted candidate at the college level shall supersede the earlier upgradation response provided by the candidate during form fill up.

5. The candidates with allotted college have to report physically and have to produce all the original certificates and necessary original documents in appropriate format to the respective colleges for verification of the original documents. If any candidates fail to produce any original certificate or original documents in appropriate format during original certificate verification, then his or her candidature will be cancelled on the spot. After verification candidates has to submit the requisite admission fees (Mention in the point No. 8) for admission in the allotted college. Candidature will be cancelled automatically if he/she fails to report on the schedule date and time to the allotted college.

The admitted candidates must deposit the original H.S. (10+2) Mark sheet and certificate or equivalent examination certificate to the allotted college authority against a receipt issued by the college authority. The receipt has to be kept secured by the candidate as after completion of course/if candidate resins from the course/if candidate gets upgraded in subsequent round of counseling, then candidate can get back originals by deposition of original receipt.

6. The following documents will be required at the time of admission:

6.(A) Candidates have to produce the domicile certificate issued by the Appropriate Authority (viz. viz. District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/ Deputy Magistrate/ Deputy Collector/Sub-divisional Officer/Block Development Officer/ Superintendent of Police/Additional Superintendent of Police/Sub-divisional Police Officer/Deputy Superintendent of Police/ Commissioner/Additional Commissioner/ Joint Commissioner/ Deputy Commissioner/ Assistant Commissioner of Police Commissionerate/Judicial Magistrate of any Rank or position in the concerned district or Metropolitan Locality or Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Corporation area-Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, assistant Commissioner/Assistant Secretary or above in the Secretariat of the Govt. Of West Bengal (including GTA) or Central Government/ Deputy Director or above in the Directorate to the Govt. of West Bengal or Central Government)/head of the institution from which the candidate has passed in 10+2 examination in the year as per existing rules/norms of Government of West Bengal, in original as per format available in the same website *vide*. Proforma-a1, a2 & b (as applicable), at the time of 1st round admission and original documents verification in the allotted college on 12.09.2022 and 13.09.2022 (Time 11 am to 4 pm). [Candidate get the proforma a1, a2 & b from the previous Notification vide Memo No. HPT/IP-04-10/Pt-VII/M/1710, dated 20.07.2022].

6.(A)-(i) Officials issuing domicile certificate must provide his/her FULL NAME, DESIGNATION, PLACE OF POSTING WITH ADDRESS, LAND LINE/ MOBILE NUMBER. He/she should also provide his/her IDENTITY CARD NUMBER if available.

6.(A) -(ii) CERTIFICATE FROM ANY AUTHORITY OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED ABOVE "WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED".

6.(A)-(iii) Note: Domicile certificate issued by any elected people's Representative such as Municipal Commissioner, Councillor of Municipal Corporation/Municipality, Member of Three tires Panchayat System or GTA, MLA or MP are not acceptable.

6.(A)-(iv) **Proforma a2** must be signed and certified by the head of the institution from which the candidate has passed in 10+2 examination in the year 2022. Such certificate must be issued after verification of the school education record of the candidates.

6.(A)-(v) **Proforma b** must be signed and certified by the appropriate authority.

Criteria to be treated as domicile and applicable proforma of certificate

Only those candidates will be treated as domicile of West Bengal, who is either,

(i) Residing in West Bengal continuously at least for last 10 (ten) years as on 31/12/2021.

OR

(ii) Whose(s) parents is/are permanent resident of West Bengal having permanent address within state of West Bengal.

7.(C) **The original medical (Physical & Mental) fitness certificate** from a Registered Medical Practitioner (West Bengal Medical Council)/Medical Officer of a Government Hospital (MBBS qualified) and a certificate from a Registered Eye Specialist, certifying acuity of vision and absence of colour blindness, in original as per format generated during online form fill up, *vide* Proforma c & d. [Candidate get the proforma c & d from the previous Notification *vide* Memo No. HPT/IP-04-10/Pt-VII/M/1710, dated 20.07.2022].

7.(C) -(i) Original and two self attested photocopy of age proof (Birth Certificate/Madhyamik admit card/any other).

7.(C)-(ii) Original and two self attested photocopies of Mark-sheet of 10+2 or equivalent examination.

7.(C)-(iii) Three stamp size and Two Passport size coloured recent photographs.

7.(C)-(iv) Original and a self attested photocopy of S.C./ S.T./O.B.C-A/O.B.C-B/P.H. Certificates in appropriate cases.

For OBC-A and OBC-B candidates, they have to additionally provide non-creamy layer certificate issued from the same authority who issued the earlier OBC-A/OBC-B certificate if the OBC-A/OBC-B certificate was issued prior to/on 31.03.2021. If OBC-A/OBC-B certificate is issued on/after 01.04.2021, then such non-creamy layer certificate is not required.

Admission of the PH candidates is subject to verification and approval by the Medical Board at SSKM Medical College & Hospital, A.J.C. Bose Road, Kolkata 700020. PH candidate should carry the original and self attested photocopy of the PH certificates issued by the Medical Board from SSKM during admission in the allotted College. After obtaining the PH certificate issued by the Medical Board from SSKM, candidates keep this certificate and have to produce in original during verification of the documents at the respective college.

The PH candidates, who fail to attend the Medical Board at SSKM Medical College & Hospital, A.J.C. Bose Road, and Kolkata 700020 on allotted dates (already notified vide Memo No. HPT/IP-04-10/Pt-VII/M/1710, Dated 20.07.2022) and not able to produce the verified PH certificate in appropriate format during verification of the original documents at the respective college then his/her candidature will be treated as cancelled.

7.(C)-(v) Self declaration form must be produced in original in appropriate format during physical verification of original documents at the respective college during admission.


8. Fees to be deposited at the allotted college during admission:

- (a) Admission fee: Rs. 500/- (b) Tuition fee: Rs.1200/- (c) Session fee: Rs. 100/-
(d) Registration: Rs. 600/- (e) Caution Deposit: Rs. 200/-
(f) Hostel Seat Rent: Rs. 1200/- (if such facility is available at the allotted college).

9. The date of reporting for original documents verification, 1st round admission at the respective allotted colleges on 12.09.2022 and 13.09.2022 (from 11 AM to 4 P.M.).

The date of reporting & admission of the GTA Sponsored students for admission at Institute of Pharmacy, Jalpaiguri on 12.09.2022 and 13.09.2022 (from 11 AM to 4 P.M.).

10. If second round counseling, online Mop-Up counselling, and centralized manual Mop-Up round required then it will be notified in the official website of Swasthya Bhawan, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal. Therefore, candidates are instructed to follow the notification of the official website of Swasthya Bhawan (www.wbhealth.gov.in).
