The objective is to introduce courses in Public Health which are modern, befitting with the need of the State and able to address local issues with a global mindset. The key focal areas of the Institute are education, research and policy formulations. A broad-based, multidisciplinary post-graduate program in public health (Masters in Public Health) has been started with affiliation of West Bengal University of Health Sciences.

2. Applications are invited for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor in Social Sciences at the Institute of Public Health, Kalyani, Nadia, West Bengal. The assistant Professor will play a major role in teaching of Social Sciences to the students under the Masters of Public Health (MPH) programme. - b) Applicants must have a Post Graduate degree in Sociology followed by PhD preferably in Social Medicine/Public Health
- c) Publications in peer-reviewed national and international academic journals would get preference.

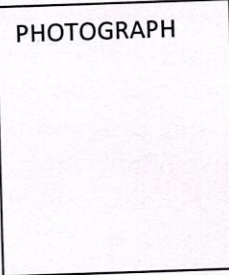
