

**GUIDELINES FOR THE MEMBERS OF SELECTION COMMITTEE RELATING TO SELECTION OF TRAINEES FOR THE G.N.M. TRAINING COURSE (FOR FEMALE) FOR THE SESSION SEPTEMBER, 2018 TO AUGUST, 2021.**

1. Nursing Deptt, Gorkha Territorial Administration, Darjeeling (for Darjeeling District Selection Committee only) being the Chairman of the Selection Committee will call a meeting with the P.N.O./Senior Sister Tutor/ and Nursing Supdt. And give permission to start the processing of the applications received till **31.05.2018**.
2. The P.N.O./Sr. Sister Tutor with the assistance of Sister Tutors of the Training School concerned will collect all the applications together and sort them out according to different categories, viz. Unreserved(General), SC, ST, OBC(A) & OBC(B) quota. The candidates belonging to Civil Defence quota and Orphanage quota will be **selected centrally (not district-wise)** at N.T.S., R.G. Kar Medical College & Hospital, 1, Khudiram Bose Sarani, Kolkata-700004
3. The applications should be recorded serially in separate register for the said different categories as per Proforma-I and the serial numbers thus obtained should be put in the space on the right top of the application as the Enrolment No. for example Malda/Gen/5 or Purulia/SC/10.
4. Now, as per proforma-II, a panel for the eligible candidates, deemed to be selected, should be made strictly on the basis of merit on percentage of Marks obtained in the H.S. Exam. (10 +2) or equivalent Exam. The percentage shall have to be calculated on the total marks of two compulsory subjects as the first language & second language (one must be English) and three higher scored elective subjects i.e. three best elective subjects i.e. out of 500. If a candidate has only one compulsory subject as English Language, her percentage of marks shall have to be calculated on this subject plus three best electives i.e. out of 400. Environmental Education will never be taken in calculation of percentage.  
If the **percentage of marks calculated in the aforesaid method be equal in case of more than one candidate**, weightage will be given to the candidates **with higher aggregate and then age**. This panel must be within the limit of number of seats for the respective district with specific provision of reservation as per rules.
5. The applications which show the candidate's under age or over age or are proved to have been applied from more than one districts and without photocopies of age-proof certificate and mark-sheet, will be sorted out and kept aside in order to be placed before selection committee for cancellation. All other applications will be kept in the selection process. If any application seems to be inappropriate for taking into selection process owing to absence of ordinary documents/ particulars/ criteria other than the aforesaid ones, this will be placed in the merit list with necessary remarks awaiting decision of the selection committee.
6. In the same manner, two waiting panels for eligible candidates who may be called on when any of the selected candidates will refuse admission or remain absent should be made and this also will be within limit of number of seats of the respective district.
7. Then, in the same manner, a list of the candidates, whose candidature will be cancelled due to non-eligibility or rejection of the application should be made mentioning the reason of cancellation.

8. All the registers, the selected panels and the waiting panels and the list of non eligible candidates should be placed before the selection committee for perusal and properly signed by all the members related to the case.

9. The selection of candidates for G.N.M. training course is likely to be held on and from **09.07.2018** and must be completed by **27.07.2018**.

10. Finally, for approval of D.H.S. (W.B.) both the selected panels and the waiting panels for each category and the report of Marks verification, as well as the list for non-eligible candidates duly signed by the members should be sent to the Jt.D.H.S. (Nursing) W.B. by **01.08.2018** positively

11. A list of selected candidates as well as waiting list, duly signed by the members should be displayed on the Notice Board of the respective training centre for perusal, after approval of the D.H.S., W.B.

12. All the applications and documents along with envelopes of candidates of the respective districts should be kept under safe custody of the P.N.O/ Senior Sister Tutor concerned of the N.T.S.

13. After selection is over, all the Mark-sheets of H.S. Exam. (10+2) or equivalent Exam. Should be sent to the respective Council/Board for verification within **13.08.2018**. The verification report is to be sent to Jt. DHS (Ng), W.B. in time.

14. The following points should also be carefully noted: -

Last date of receiving of the application is **31.05.2018**. Joining of the selected candidates to the respective training school should be from **05.09.2018 to 15.09.2018**. Age limit of the candidates- from 17 years to 27 years as on 01.01.2018 should be strictly followed.

1. After just expiry of last date of submission of application, the Superintendent, Ashoknagar S.G. Hospital, North 24 Parganas being the Chairman of the selection committee will call a meeting with the Senior Sister Tutor-in-Charge, Nursing Superintendent and other Sister Tutors of N.T.S Ashoknagar S.G Hospital, and give permission to start the processing of the applications received till **31.05.2018**
2. On the commencement of selection, in presence of other members of the Selection Committee, the Senior Sister Tutor-in-Charge with the assistance of Sister Tutors of the N.T.S., will collect all the applications together and sort them out according to different categories, viz. Unreserved, SC, ST, OBC(A), OBC(B) category
3. In separate registers for the categories viz. Unreserved, SC etc. the applications should be recorded serially as per **Proforma-I** and the serial numbers thus obtained should be put on the right top of the application as the enrolment number for example- U.R./5 or SC/10 so that the total number of applications in each category can be counted.
4. Now, as per **proforma-II**, a panel for the eligible candidates, deemed to be selected, should be made strictly on the basis of merit on percentage of Marks obtained in the H.S. Exam. (10 +2) or equivalent Exam. The percentage shall have to be calculated on the total marks of two compulsory subjects as the first language & second language (one must be English) and three higher scored elective subjects i.e. three best elective subjects i.e. out of 500. If a candidate has only one compulsory subject as English Language, her percentage of marks shall have to be calculated on this subject plus three best electives i.e. out of 400. Environmental Education will never be taken in calculation of percentage.
