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Notice for pre-counselling and counselling 2018 for admission in BAMS (Bachelor in Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery), BHMS (Bachelor in Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery) and BUMS (Bachelor in Unani Medicine and Surgery) courses in Government and Private AYUSH Colleges of West Bengal for the session 2018-2019

The candidates who have qualified through NEET UG 2018 conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and are domicile to the State of West Bengal and willing to participate in the **pre-counselling and counselling 2018 for admission in BAMS (Bachelor in Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery), BHMS (Bachelor in Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery) and BUMS (Bachelor in Unani Medicine and Surgery) courses in Government and Private AYUSH Colleges of West Bengal for the session 2018-2019** have to follow certain steps as listed below:

The pre-counselling phase is introduced to prepare the State wise Merit list of West Bengal for participation in State UG AYUSH Counselling (BAMS, BHMS and BUMS) 2018 from candidates who become qualified through NEET UG 2018 and domicile to the State of West Bengal for Government Colleges and Private Colleges. NEET UG qualified candidates, those are resident of other States, eligible for admission in Payment seats of Pvt. Colleges only.

DOMICILE CERTIFICATE:

The types of domicile proforma uploaded in the websites www.wbhealth.gov.in is described herewith:

Proforma a1: Residential/Domicile Certificate for candidates residing in the State of West Bengal continuously for at least last 10 years as on 31st December of 2017.

Proforma a2: Residential/Domicile Certificate for candidates residing in the State of West Bengal continuously for at least last 10 years as on 31st December of 2017 and who has passed 10+2 Examination in the year 2018 or before from an Institution of West Bengal.

Proforma b: Residential/Domicile Certificate for candidates NOT residing in the State of West Bengal but whose parent(s) are permanent resident(s) of West Bengal having their permanent Home address within West Bengal for at least 10 years on 31st December of 2017.

Local Residence (Domicile) certificate obtained from West Bengal e-District Portal <http://edistrict.wb.gov.in/PACE> will also be accepted as proof of domicile.

For candidates furnishing proforma b, the parent whose domicile is placed must also produce original Voter ID Card or Adhar Card or Passport (any two of the three as mentioned herewith) for additional proof of domicile during the stage of document verification where the said ID cards show that the residential address in West Bengal.

Who are authorized to sign the domicile /residential Certificate-

Proforma a1 or b must be signed and certified by any of the following competent authorities of State Govt. or Central Govt. having local jurisdiction of the place of permanent residence of the candidate or the parent as the case may be e.g.:

1. District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Deputy Magistrate, Deputy Collector, Sub Divisional Officer, Block Development Officer.
2. Superintendent of Police, Additional Superintendent of Police, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Divisional Police Officer.
3. Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner of Police Commissionerate.
4. Judicial Magistrate of any rank or position in the concerned district or Metropolitan locality or Hon'ble High court at Calcutta or Hon'ble Supreme court of India.
5. Corporation area: Commissioner, Additional Commissioner. Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner.
6. Assistant Secretary or above in the Secretariat of Govt. of west Bengal (including GTA) or Central Govt.
7. Deputy Director or above in the Directorate of Govt. of West Bengal or Central Govt.

Every Official certifying the domicile status of candidate or parent must provide his/her Full Name, Designation and Place of Posting with Address, Landline or Mobile Number. He /She should also provide his/her identity card number if available.

Certification from any other authority other than those enumerated above will not be accepted.

Domicile/residential certificate issued by the people's representative like Municipal Commissioner, Councilor of Municipal Corporation/ Municipality, Member of three tier Panchayet System or GTA, Member of Legislative Assembly or Member of Parliament will not be accepted.

Proforma a2 must be signed and certified by the Head Master/ Principal/Director of the Institution from which the candidates have passed 10+2 in 2018.

STEPS OF ONLINE REGISTRATION & COUNSELLING:

Thus the following things are required to be informed by the candidates who qualified through **NEET UG 2018** in pre counselling by clicking the website during the time schedule as published in www.wbhealth.gov.in and :

1. **Domicile status of the candidate:**
 - (i) If the candidate or parent/s is domicile for WB then he/she is eligible to participate both in Govt. AYUSH Colleges and free /payment seats in Pvt. AYUSH Colleges.
 - (ii) If the candidate or parent/s is not domicile of WB then the candidate is eligible to participate in counseling for payment seats in Pvt. AYUSH Colleges only.
2. **Caste Status of candidate:** If the candidate is SC/ST as per filled up form in CBSE and the result handed over to the Dept. of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of WB by MOHFW,GOI then the candidate will have to answer whether the certificate WAS ISSUED BY AUTHORITY IN WEST BENGAL. If the answer is YES, then the candidates are able to fill choice for reserved seats as per rule.

Reservation of seats for OBC-A/B candidates in different Colleges will not be implemented in this session till the enhancement of seats for accommodating OBC candidates as per section 5(2) of the West Bengal State Higher Education Institutions (Reservation in admission) Act, 2013 in each College.

3. **Physically challenged status:** Degree of disability will be determined as per Benchmark Physical Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of IPGMER, Kolkata issued within stipulated time frame. No other PH certificate, issued by any other Authority/ Hospital will be entertained. The Benchmark Disabilities are as per Disability Act of 2016
4. As per notification of Ministry of AYUSH, G.O.I. vide F.No.R-13040/33/2016-Tech.(Part) dated 11.06.2018 Candidate willing to participate in NEET UG 2018 counseling for AYUSH colleges must obtain on and above **50th percentile for unreserved category, 45th percentile for PWD category and 40th percentile for SC/ST category in NEET Merit list.**
5. All candidates willing to admit in **BHMS course** must have passed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and for **BAMS/BUMS course** must obtain 50% marks taken together Physics, Chemistry and Biology in 10+2 Examination as per C.C.H./C.C.I.M. guidelines.
6. Candidates can opt for **up gradation** at the time of choice filling during online counselling.


7. After the above information is furnished by the candidate, if the candidate is eligible for fee payment then he/she will be directed to the online payment gateway where he/she can pay NON REFUNDABLE pre counseling and counseling fee ONLINE only through credit /debit card or net banking.
Online counseling fees Rs. 200/- for Unreserved and Rs.100/- for SC/ST/PH candidates. Bank transaction cost extra to be borne by the candidate concerned.
8. The date and time of online information submission and fee payment is between 12 noon of 16.08.18 till midnight of 28.08.18(as per server time). No further request of extension of time for information submission and fee payment will be entertained. **If the candidate fails to participate in pre counseling then there is no chance to participate in counseling or seat allotment or admission later on.**
9. Next step of action to be taken for candidates is to go for Physical verification at Swasthya Bhawan Auditorium (2nd Floor) Wings-A, GN-29, Sector-V, Saltlake, Kolkata-70091 as will be indicated in the print out taken after online payment by the candidate from website www.wbhealth.gov.in with precise date and time of verification.

The documents (in original and self attested photocopy) that are essentially required during the verification are:

- a. NEET UG 2018 Result/Rank Card issued by CBSE.
 - b. Domicile certificate(a1,a2,b or West Bengal e-district Domicile Certificate) as the case may be .
 - c. Voter ID card or Aadhar Card or Passport of the candidate or of parent/s in case of domicile certificate of parent is given in showing address as West Bengal(any 2 of three ID cards as mentioned above)
 - d. Caste certificate as applicable.
 - e. PWD certificate issued from IPGMER, Kolkata as applicable.
 - f. Proof of payment of counseling fees.
 - g. Age proof(age should be 17 years by 31.12.2018)
 - h. Class 10+2 mark sheet for verification of marks.
 - i. Medical certificate (from Registered Medical Practitioner)
10. After proper verification if the authority finds that candidature is valid then the print copy of verified and approved slip will be generated and handed over to the candidate for future reference. Otherwise verified and cancelled slip will be printed out and similarly handed over to such candidates. Cancelled candidates will not further feature in West Bengal merit list and will not be allowed to participate in next counseling.
11. **Admission to AYUSH UG Colleges in the State for 2018-2019 session will be done subject to getting permission for affiliation of each AYUSH Institution from Central Council of Homoeopathy/Central Council for Indian Medicines/ Ministry of AYUSH, GOI and the same will be reflected in SEAT MATRIX.**

12. THINGS TO BE REMEMBERED:

- Willing NEET qualified candidates must register first within stipulated time (28.08.18).
- The schedules of verification process will be published in the website www.wbhealth.gov.in
- The State of West Bengal Merit list as per applied and verified candidate will be published in the website www.wbhealth.gov.in
- The candidates in merit list can go for one time online registration, choice filling, choice locking and up gradation as per schedule provided in the website www.wbhealth.gov.in
- Not reported /declined candidates will be out of counseling.
- PWD candidates once obtained certificate of Disability from IPGMER, Kolkata or other mentioned Institutes for MBBS/BDS counseling are also eligible after production of the same at the time of verification.
- The allotted candidates after first round counseling will have to deposit the amount of Rs. 3100/- as token admission fees to the College. If he /she opt for up gradation in second round of counseling the token admission fee will be adjusted, if upgraded from Govt. to Govt. College of same discipline and admission fees (Rs.3100/-) will be forfeited and if upgraded from Pvt. to Govt. or Pvt. to Pvt. college. All the final admission in AYUSH colleges must be completed on and before 19.09.2018.
- For any kind of suppression of facts /information related to admission in BHMS/BAMS/BUMS courses in West Bengal through counselling 2018 for Govt. and Pvt. AYUSH Colleges or fabricated information furnished by candidate will lead to cancellation of the candidature with immediate effect and would also instigate punitive action.

The College authorities have to admit candidates after checking the original documents and self attested photocopies of the candidates allotted to them through online counselling. The result will be published in www.wbhealth.gov.in website as per schedule.

The documents that are required during admission in original and one self-attested photocopy are stated herewith:

- i) Admit card of NEET UG 2018 Exam issued by Central Board of Secondary Education.
- ii) Result/Rank letter issued by CBSE.
- iii) Class 10 certificate/Class 10 Admit card as age Proof (Candidates must attain 17 years as on 31.12.2018)
- iv) Class 10 certificate.
- v) Class 10+2 certificate.
- vi) Class 10+2 Marksheet (All candidates must have passed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually for admission in BHMS course and in addition that for BAMS/BUMS course must obtain 50% marks taken together Physics, Chemistry and Biology as per CCH/CCIM guidelines.
- vii) Provisional allotment letter generated on-line.
- viii) Any one valid proof of identity (School or college ID card/Voter Card/Aadhar Card/Passport/Driving License/PAN card).
- ix) Medical Certificate from Registered Allopathic Medical Practitioner.
- x) FINAL SUCCESSFULLY VERIFIED SLIP generated online from www.wbhealth.gov.in for **admission** in West Bengal Under Graduate Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic and Unani seats in Government Colleges and Private AYUSH Colleges in free and payment seats after documents verified candidates at the verification centers.
- xi) The Candidate should also bring the following certificate, if applicable:
 - (a) SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority.
 - (b) Benchmark Physical Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of IPGMER, Kolkata issued within stipulated time frame. No other PH certificate, issued by any other Authority/ Hospital will be entertained. The Benchmark Disabilities are as per Disability Act of 2016. Candidates those have already collected Disability Certificate for MBBS/BDS counseling from mentioned authorities are also eligible for Online counseling but have to produce the same at the time of verification.

During admission, College authorities will keep all the self attested photocopies and all the Original documents except Age proof, ID Card and caste certificate and will issue a receipt stating that such and such original documents are kept along with the college authorities.


The deposited documents will be handed over to the candidates during the up gradation from that college to another college in Round 2 or at the time of Final admission in allotted college.

The allotted candidates after first round counseling will have to deposit the amount of Rs. 3100/- as token admission fees to the College. If he /she opt for up gradation in second round of counseling the token admission fee will be adjusted, if upgraded from Govt. to Govt. College of same discipline and admission fees (Rs.3100/-) will be forfeited and if upgraded from Pvt. to Govt. or Pvt. to Pvt. college. All the final admission in AYUSH colleges must be completed on and before 19.09.2018. **All the college authorities must run their admission procedures at the College premises only.**

Candidates must consult the Private Colleges for fees to be deposited during admission in Free /Payment seats and College authority should provide fees structure to the candidates for entire course. The contact details of the Private colleges will be provided in Participating Institute information in www.wbhealth.gov.in website for ready reference to the candidates.

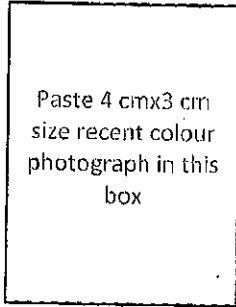

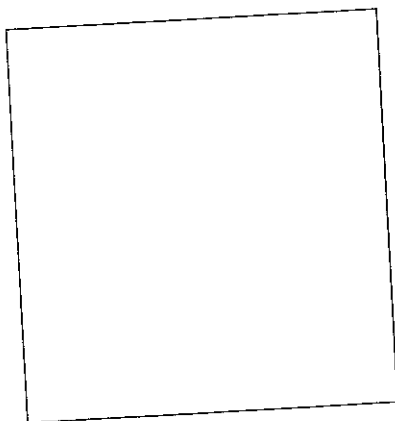

Clarification on behalf of Medical Council of India in respect of the various categories of candidates who wish to appear in NEET-UG-2018 after the Amendment Notified on 22.01.2018 to the Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997 whereby proviso to Regulation 4(2)(a) has been inserted

This is to inform all concerned that in WP (C) No. 1813 of 2018 – Anshul vs. Union of India & Ors and connected matters before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi the proviso to Regulation 4 (2) (a) of the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997 notified in the Official Gazette on 23.01.18 has been challenged.

2. During the course of proceedings on 24.04.18 the Council has submitted the following chart whereby a clarification regarding eligibility of various categories of candidates who wish to appear in the NEET-UG-2018 has been submitted to the Hon'ble Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. It has been directed by the Hon'ble High Court to place the below-mentioned chart for information of all concerned on the website of the Council.

1.	Candidate having qualified 10+2 examination i.e. after 12 years of study, where the last two years of study comprise of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and any other elective subject with English from a Recognized Board. Candidates must have regular, co-terminus, simultaneous teaching and training in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology in Class 11 th & 12 th alongwith practicals in Classroom mode in a Regular School.	Meets the test of regular and continuous two years of study of Physics / Chemistry / Biology or Biotechnology alongwith practicals taken together in Class 11 th & 12 th , hence Eligible.
2.	Candidates who have studied Biology / Biotechnology as 6 th subject in Class 11 th & 12 th including practicals alongwith the other mandatory subjects with practicals in Classroom mode in a Regular School and possess a consolidated pass mark-sheet of Class 11 th & 12 th of a Recognized Board stating marks of all six subjects including Biology/ Biotechnology.
