**Advertisement for admission in One year Certificate Course of Panchakarma Assistant 2020-2021**

Online applications are invited for admission in One year Certificate Course of 'Panchakarma Assistant' in the Institute at Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital, Government of West Bengal, 29, S.K. Dev Road, Kolkata- 700 048, attached to J B Roy State Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata.

**A. Eligibility for Admission:**

The students will be admitted to Certificate Course of Panchakarma Assistant, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions.

- a) That he/she is a permanent resident of West Bengal and has passed class XII (10+2) Examination with Physics, Chemistry & Biology or Mathematics from a school recognized by the WBCHSE / ICSE / CBSE.
- b) That he/she should not be less than 16 years and more than 30 years as on **1<sup>st</sup> June 2020**, for the admission. Relaxation of age for S.C. & S.T. candidates is 3 years as on **1<sup>st</sup> June 2020**.
- c) That he/she is of good character to be certified by the Head of the Institution where he/she studied last.

**B. Submission of Application**

- a) Online application form will be available in the Department website i.e. [www.wbhealth.gov.in](http://www.wbhealth.gov.in)
- b) Incomplete application shall be liable to be rejected.

**C. Selection of Condition**

- a) Admission will be on merit basis. Merit list for admission will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Physics + Chemistry + Biology or Physics + Chemistry + Mathematics, whichever is higher, in the H.S. (10+2)/CBSE/ICSE. The merit list will be valid for 60 days only.
- b) Counseling: provisionally selected candidates for counseling will have to appear at the Institute on the specified date and time when so called for, at their own expenses.
- c) Total number of seats: 20 (twenty)
- d) Reservation of Seats: As per existing Rules of Government of West Bengal.
- e) Counseling and Admission will be intimated later.

**Attested copies of the following documents are to be uploaded with application.**

1. Copy of the Mark Sheet of XII (10+2) Examination or equivalent.
2. Copy of the Age proof.
3. Copy of the Character Certificate by the Head of last attended institution.
4. Copy of residential Certificate issued by the Competent Authority (Viz M.P. / M.L.A. / Member of Zila Parishad / Sabhapati of the PanchayatSamity / Commissioner of Municipality / Councillor/ Prodhan of Gram Panchayat / B. D. O. of the Area / any Officer of or above the Rank of Asstt. Secretary to the Government of West Bengal etc. as per existing rules / norms of Government of West Bengal.
5. If belong to S.C. / S. T. / P. H. copy of the Certificate issued by the competent authority as per existing rules / norms of Government of West Bengal.

## Selection Procedures:

1. Candidates will be selected on the basis of total marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics or Biology (**whichever higher**) at the H.S (10+2) Examination (General Stream) or equivalent examination as approved by the Pharmacy Council of India. Candidates have to separately pass both the theory and practical examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (if Biology is considered for merit list).

### 2. Other Information:


2.a. One downloaded submitted hard copy of the application along with all documents (original and one photocopy each) to be produced by the candidates during counselling in the college which will be intimated later.

2.b. Candidates have to produce the original medical (Physical and Mental) fitness certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner ( West Bengal Medical Council) Medical Officer of a Government Hospital and a **certificate from a Registered Eye Specialist, certifying acuity of vision and absence of colour blindness**, in original as per format available in website-vide. Proforma-b&c, during counselling in respective college.

2.c. Admission of PH candidates is subject to verification of PH status by the Central Medical Board at SSKM, Kolkata, Verified certificate approved by the Central Medical Board- at SSKM, Kolkata. Candidate should carry the original and photocopy of caste / physical handicap certificates, issued by the Competent Authority during admission in respective college.

2.d. **Last date of online submission of application along with scan copy of uploaded documents is 18/10/2020 by 4.00 P.M.**
