**Sub: Request for ensuring mandatory uploading of Laboratory testing data with line list  
of all positive cases for DENGUE and MALARIA with effect from 1<sup>st</sup>.June,2018.**


Sir/Madam,

You are aware that in our state *four* Vector Borne Diseases e.g. MALARIA, DENGUE, KALA AZAR and JEPANESE ENCEPHALITIS are declared as NOTIFIABLE DISEASES by Gazette notification. The details are available in the department website ([www.wbhealth.gov.in](http://www.wbhealth.gov.in)). Considering the testing load and total number of positive cases is has been decided by the department of Health & Family Welfare, GoWB, that the data needs to be handled through a dedicated on-line server to avoid human errors of omission & commission. Also this will help in generation of analysis and alerts. More over for Malaria this data capturing will be helpful towards elimination of Malaria. This type of data capturing will cover both Govt & Private Units.

With this objective all the Testing Laboratories registered under C.E.Act in West Bengal will have to report by uploading the testing data along with the line list of all test positive cases regularly & in time. The access will be through the User.id & pass word of the individual licensed Laboratories only. Registered establishments under C.E.Act other than Laboratories will not report through this server. Date of reporting will mean the calendar date of reporting. Reporting period means 24 hrs previous to the date of reporting (from midnight to midnight). If any ELISA based test for Dengue diagnosis &/or any diagnostic test for malaria has been performed during the 24 hr reporting period, the necessary information have to be entered into the software positively within 3.00 PM of the reporting date. For editing the entered data will be accessible till next 24hrs (3.00 PM of subsequent day). A photocopy of the fields to be uploaded is enclosed for your ready reference. Few fields have been made mandatory considering the importance of those particular information for epidemiological analysis.

You are requested to complete all preparatory activities so that Lab data is uploaded in real time through the server from 1<sup>st</sup>. June,2018 without fail. You are further requested to kindly submit the contact details of the nodal person to the licensing authority and the details of the tests which are performed and to be reported by the unit ( for Dengue: ELISA NS1 & ELISA IgM. For Malaria: RDT,Blood Slide).
