It is hereby notified to the general member of public and specially all the registered practitioners of Ayurved and Unani whose name are enrolled in the Register of their respective State Council i.e. Paschimbanga Ayurved Parishad and State Council of Unani Medicine, West Bengal upto 15/05/2018 that election to the Central Council of Indian Medicine to represent the Ayurved and Unani system of Medicine for the State of West Bengal will be held as per Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (Act No. 48 of 1970) read with Notification No. S.O. 3322 (E) dated 26th October 2016 of the Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India

It is also notified that:

1. The Office of the Joint Secretary, Government of West Bengal, 6th Floor, A Wing, Swasthya Bhavan, GN – 29, Sector – V, Salt Lake City, Kolkata – 700 091 will be the office of the Returning Officer for the purpose of holding the CCIM Election.
2. The number of members to be elected from the State to the Central Council of Indian Medicine to represent the Ayurved and Unani system is one (1) each.
3. The draft Electoral List (Updated State Register of Ayurved and Unani practitioners) is on display at the Office of Returning Officer from 13/04/2018 to 14/05/2018 excepting Saturday, Sunday and Holidays.
4. Nomination forms may be obtained from the Office of the Returning Officer on any day except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays 11:00 a.m. to 15:00 p.m. from 18/05/2018 to 01/06/2018.
5. Nomination papers should be delivered to the undersigned personally by the candidate or his/her authorized representative on or before 01/06/2018 on all days except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays 11:00 a.m. to 15:00 p.m.
6. The nomination papers will be taken up for scrutiny by the undersigned at 12.00 p.m. on 04/06/2018.
7. Last date and time for withdrawal of nomination by the candidate will be 11/06/2018 on 15.00 p.m..

List of contesting candidates will be displayed at the office of the Returning Officer at 17.00 p.m. on 11/06/2018.

9. Voting papers will be sent to the electors by Registered Post latest by 12/07/2018 on 17.00 p.m.
10. The last date and time for the receipt of voting papers from the electors shall be 12/08/2018 within 5.00 p.m. whether delivered by post or inserted personally in the voting box kept in the office of the Returning Officer.
11. The Voting papers shall be taken up for scrutiny and counting at the office of the Returning Officer on 13/08/2018 at 11.00 a.m.
